Beauty and spontaneity of the genuine artistic expression of children presents us with creative enrichment of our cultural and spiritual values. We are delighted to be part of the common European Union area what encourages us to offer creativity of the Slovak children to Europe in this joint project realised together with the III European School in Brussels. The initial idea of the project EURO-FAIRY-TALES is to prepare children for united Europe created for common good of our nations and thus strengthen our European identity since early childhood. Moreover, showing splendour of the child's soul expressed by paintbrush inspires also us to remember our values.

28 fairy-tales typical for every European country are interpreted by artistic expression by using different techniques such as painting or figural compositions by pre-school children from 28 Slovak cities together with 12 different linguistic sections of the III European School in Brussels. This becomes a unique exhibition permitting to perceive two different artistic expressions of one subject hosted in Brussels by ifa laboratory working with art as method. Ifa laboratory has the belief that art can be used to the benefit of different strata of society whether the simple individual, a neighbourhood, a business, an organisation, a government. Various methodical materials were made available for educational purposes stemming from this pedagogical experience of working with children for several months.
