Ozlem Habibe Mutaf Buyukarman studied art and design in both Istanbul and San Francisco. She had her undergraduate degree from Marmara University Faculty of Fine Arts, Graphic Arts (2001), and her graduate degree from San Francisco State University, College of Creative Arts (2003). She graduated with the Outstanding Graduate Award from SFSU. She worked as Art Director in advertising for several years. She has been teaching Graphic Design at Yeditepe University Faculty of Fine Arts Graphic Design Department since 2011 as an Assistant Professor and currently as the department head.

She had many international awards and exhibitions. Her works were exhibited in London, New York, Texas, Florida, San Francisco, Brussels, Istanbul... Recently, she had her solo exhibition Abandoned in Istanbul. She participated in The Traces of Don Quixote, From Picasso to Dali, International Exhibition, Artrooms London International Contemporary Art Fair, 31st Annual International Juried Exhibition of The University of Texas at Tyler, The Mark On The Wall Exhibition related to The 25th Annual Virginia Woolf and Her Female Contemporaries. She also exhibited in the International Art Festival New York as the Jury's Choice Award Winner in 2015.
