About the works

Dace Lucia Kidd strives to communicate a conviction that reminds us, in an age where visual trickery has become the norm that direct experience still holds surprises and offers fresh insights.

Through her relationship to art history, notably modernism, she perceives new compositions which weave a framework of aesthetics and traditional composition toward an evolved balance between simple visual stimulation and complex contemporary ideals.

Using three dimensional surface layered with two dimensional images she establishes a unique relationship between artist, viewer and object.

Biography

Dace Lucia Kidd (b.1987 in Riga, Latvia) is a classically trained American/Latvian artist who is currently residing in Texas and is working primarily in the media of oil on canvas. Her installations and paper sculptures along with her large scale drawings and paintings are better known in Europe.

She completed her degree work at Art Academy of Latvia in Riga and received advanced training for two years at Academia di belle Arti in Palermo, on the island of Sicily.

The artist recounts the story of her mother taking her to the first real art shop to open after her country fought for independence from Russia in 1991. Seeing that her child was gifted, she spent two weeks salary on a brush and some paint. Her mother's gesture will never be forgotten. Dace still has that brush and remains committed to creating a pathway to communicate through her art.
